Contract Benefits – BPD has a Union negotiated contract which also contains a Sunset clause

- State of Idaho PERS City contribution of 11.66% with employee contribution of 8.36%
- 6.2% City Contribution to 457, does not require employee contribution
- Optional PERSI Choice 401K
- Optional Roth after tax plan
- \$1,200 annual clothing allowance, after first year of employment
- \$480 cleaning credits a year for a local dry cleaner
- 10 hours’ vacation per month increasing to 18 hours per month based on years of service
- 8 hours’ sick time per month
- Sick leave buy down to VEBA PEHP for post-employment health care coverage (tax free!)
 - Any time over 600 hours each year is bought down at 60% and placed in a postemployment healthcare plan (PEHP) to help pay your medical premiums from retirement to Medicare
- 480-hour comp bank with annual sell back down to 240 hours
- 3-hour minimum for Court appearance
- 3-hour cancellation payment inside of 48 hours
- 4 10-hour shifts, 3 consecutive days off per week
- Shift differential 3% Swings 5% Nights
- Can carry your own rifle, within certain limitations, on duty
- Monthly open range – unlimited department issued hand gun ammunition available to all officers at no cost
- Life insurance and long term disability plans available through the City of Boise at group rates
- Flexible spending account for dependent care or non-reimbursable medical expenses
- Our fleet is comprised of 2012-17 Dodge Chargers, 2013-14 Ford Explorers, and BMW motorcycles
 - We rotate vehicles out at 100k miles or 5 years
 - Approx. 45% of department is assigned take home vehicles
- All safety equipment is provided, along with initial allotment of uniforms.

BPD has a self-insured health trust with benefits to age 65 (includes dental and vision). There are four health plans to choose from, and contributions are on a monthly basis. Here’s what some of the options look like:
